Value-Based Payment Committee Report	G.Thompson	G.Thompson moved the 2023 Integrus contract be accepted for \$161,750.00. The scope of work within the 2023 Integrus contract includes continuous quality improvement (CQI) coaching of the CMHF Liaisons (S.Jones and R.DePriest), data management with T.Lichty and the CMHF Liaisons, establishing regular educational components for the CMHF agencies, and assuring regular reporting using reliable data for several levels of use (internal staff, Board, grantees, external/public). Board discussion followed. T.Cummings presented the budget foundation for the value-based payment initiative. Currently, each VBP agency has the opportunity to receive an additional 8% incentive payment based off their contract. The key domains that agencies are reporting on are: access to care, employee retention, the participant's experience, other areas, and in the future, Diversity, Inclusion, Equity, and Accessibility (DIEA).
